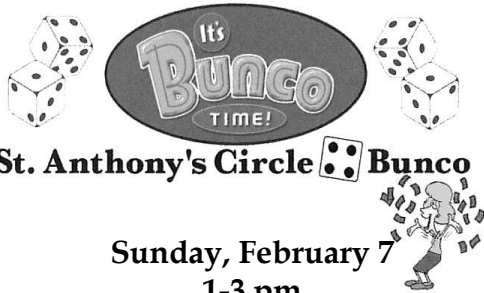
St. Anthony's Over the Top Drive is off to a promising start. This campaign's purpose is to address the ADA shortfall. The board at
