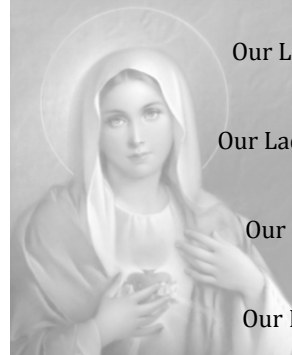


Sacred Heart Roof Update!
