St. Anthony Restoration Project

For approximately two years now, I, while being advised by the finance and parish council, have spoken to our parishioners about the restoration of St. Anthony's church as it approaches its centennial milestone which will be celebrated on Saturday, June 17, 2017. Last year, we were happy to see completed tuck pointing and the concrete work at the front and the east side.

This year we are turning to the interior of the church. There will be plaster repairs to the walls and ceiling, as well as, repairs to the ornate capitols of the columns. If you look carefully there is bailing wire that is wrapped around some of the capitols. In addition to that, there will be repainting to the interior. Please note the painted mural in the apse (above the high altar) is in excellent condition and will NOT be touched!

So - the scope of the project indoors is extensive. It will require scaffolding to be put up in the whole of the body of the church. Due to this, Mass will NOT be celebrated in the Church. They are going to start with the scaffolding on February 2nd. It looks like we will be out of the church for two months. This will translate to some changes to our schedule.

While work is happening, Saturday evening Mass will be at **Sacred Heart** in Annawan at 4 pm with confessions at 3 to 3:45. The Sunday 9:30 Mass will be at St. Anthony's **Hall**. The weekday schedule will be altered as well. The Tuesday evening Mass at 5:30 pm and Thursday 8 a.m. Mass will be in St.

Anthony Hall. Friday morning Mass will be at **Sacred Heart**.

So the **regular schedule** will look like this:

 Tues. 5:30 pm **SA Hall**
 Wed. **8:00** am SH
 Thurs. 8:00 am **SA Hall**
 Friday. 8:00 am **SH**
 Saturday. 4:00 pm **SH** (confessions at 3 pm)
 Sunday. 8 am SH (confessions at 7:30 am)
 9:30 am **SA Hall**

I understand this will be an inconvenience but let us be focused on the end result. Also, when considering all the many sacrifices our forbearers made to St. Anthony, it would be well to consider we are doing our part so that future generations can enjoy and appreciate St. Anthony's as their spiritual home. This is a lot to take in at this time so I will make an appeal for donations for this project next week.
