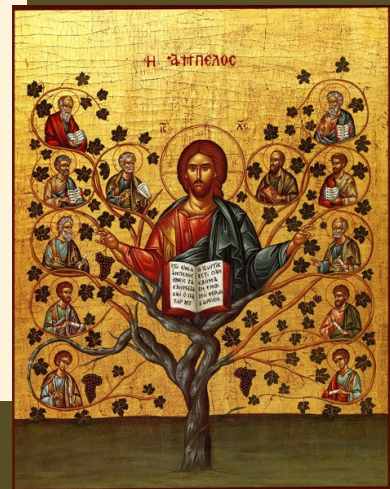

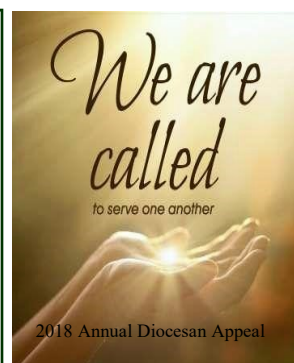

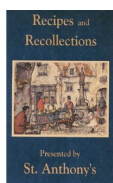
Christ the King Church "Garden of Eden Sale"
