Did you know that there is a **Children's ADA**? The Diocese of Peoria finds that it is vital, for children at a young age, to understand the importance of giving to others and supporting

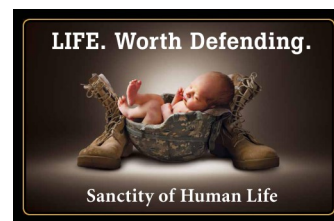
