Due to Priests' Assembly Days, please note that our daily Mass on Tuesday will be at 8:00am instead of the usual 5:30pm. This is a chance for priests of the dioceses to be together with our Bishop.

This year November 1st falls on a Saturday. Therefore, it is not obligatory to attend that day. Your Sunday obligation to attend Mass is fulfilled Saturday when All Saints are commemorated or Sunday when All Souls are commemorated.

Practicing Faithful Citizenship flows from well-formed conscience. What do we mean when we refer to "conscience"? According to the Catechism of the "Catholic Church, paragraph 1777, "Moral conscience, present at the heart of the person, enjoins him at the appropriate moment to do good and to avoid evil. It also judges particular choices, approving those that are good and denouncing those that are evil. It bears witness to the authority of truth in reference to the supreme Good to which the human person is drawn, and it welcomes the commandments. When he listens to his

conscience, the prudent man can hear God speaking." Conscience is the carrier of truth, not of self-will.

Thank you to all who have made a pledge to the **Annual Diocesan Appeal**. St. Anthony's has 131 pledges totaling \$24,721.02 or 78% toward our Diocesan goal of \$31,619. Election Prayer for Life
