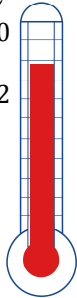

Thank you to all who have made a pledge to the **Annual Diocesan Appeal**.

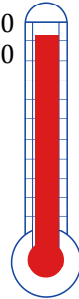
