Other members are: Karen Griffiths, Dick VanKerrebroeck, Sue Ann Wells, Marlene DeMay, Angie Kluever, Carol Sue VanOpdorp and Rod Jackson. This committee will finalize plans to implement programs and procedures that will meet the needs of Sacred Heart's parishioners now and in the

future and attract former and new members to the parish. A second committee, Buildings & Grounds was also formed consisting of Vern Griffiths, Jerry De Smith, Eugene Van De Voorde, Dick McKibbon, Vic Kluever and chairman, Eric Ufhel. This committee is charged with developing a plan for the parish infrastructure that will meet the current and future needs of the parish. Both committees will do the necessary research to obtain cost estimates and develop a time-line for their recommendations to be included in the final Strategic Plan. When completed, the plan will be submitted to the parish for approval before any action is taken. A third committee has been formed and met with Father Engelbrecht to reestablish the Altar and Rosary Society at Sacred Heart. Next Meeting of the Strategic Planning Committees will be held at 7:00 PM, February 26th in the parish hall. An informational meeting for Altar & Rosary will be held on February 10th at 7 PM. All women of Sacred Heart Parish are welcome to attend.
