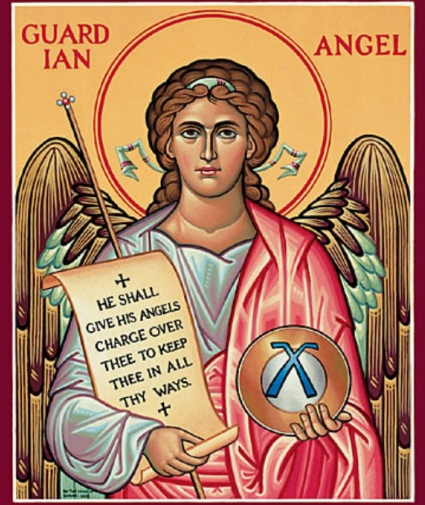

SAINT ANTHONY CENTENNIAL ORNAMENTS

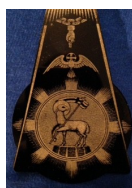
