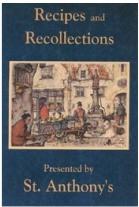

Forty-four years ago a court decision was rendered on the 23rd of January, which legalized abortion throughout the entire nine months of pregnancy. This decision, Roe v.
