Sunday Memo From our Pastor

It is on March 1st that Lent begins with Ash Wednesday. Masses with the distribution of ashes will be at 8:00 am at Sacred Heart and 6 pm at St. Anthony's Hall. This is a reminder that Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. Please see below the requirements for fasting and abstinence. One of the many treasures of the Church down through the centuries is the marking of time. From a Catholic perspective you do not really know how to feast when Easter comes until you have fasted during Lent. So let us enter into the holy season of Lent with an open heart to what our Lord wants to teach us. The 40 days of Lent remind us of the 40 days that Jesus fasted in the wilderness.

We participate in Lent through our prayers, fasting (giving up food, sweets, television etc.) and almsgiving (doing good for another). So as we approach Lent, let us consider how the Lord is calling us to keep the season holy so as to have the best ever Easter. Please consider some of the following opportunities to make this a good Lenten season:

* Stations of the Cross

- * Rice Bowls will be distributed to help the poor locally and world wide by Catholic Relief Services. (available at both parishes)
- * Food Pantry

Regulations for Lent and the Easter Triduum

- Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests, religious and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.
- Everyone of 14 years of age or over is bound to $abstain\ from\ meat$ on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017 and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Everyone 18 years or age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017 and Good Friday, April 14, 2017.
- On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously

affected, the law does not oblige.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.

On Ash Wednesday, March 1st our diocese will take up the Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. This collection provides vital funding for our brothers and sisters living in countries that were once under communist rule. Restoring the Church, in both its structures and its spiritual life, has been difficult, but with your support we can help build a brighter future for this region. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the collection this year.
