



Sunday Memo From our Pastor

Please see below the requirements for fasting and abstinence. One of the many treasures of the Church down through the centuries is the marking of time. From a Catholic perspective you do not really know how to feast when Easter comes until you have fasted during Lent. The 40 days of Lent remind us of the 40 days that Jesus fasted in the wilderness.

We participate in Lent through our prayers, fasting (giving up food, sweets, television etc.) and almsgiving (doing good for another). So as we approach Lent, let us consider how the Lord is calling us to keep the season holy so as to have the best ever Easter. Please consider some of the following opportunities to make this a good Lenten season:

Confessions:

Saturdays 3:15-3:50 pm at Sacred Heart Sundays 7:30-7:50 am at Sacred Heart Fridays 5:00 -5:20 pm (before stations) at SH

- * Attend Mass during the week
- * Stations of the Cross

Fridays at 5:30 pm at Sacred Heart

- * Rice Bowls will be distributed to help the poor locally and world wide by Catholic Relief Services. (available at both parishes)
- Food Pantry

Regulations for Lent and the Easter Triduum

- Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests, religious and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.
- Everyone of 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017 and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Everyone 18 years or age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017 and Good Friday, April 14, 2017.
- 4. On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 5. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.

The **Henry County Right to Life** is offering a **scholarship** to qualifying students who live in Henry County. Any high school senior or student who will be a freshman, sophomore or junior at an accredited college is eligible. Applications and essay are due by March 15, 2017. Packets are available at both Sacred Heart Church and St. Anthony's Hall.
