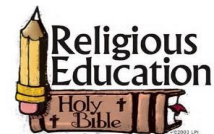

This weekend we welcome Father John from Saint John Paul II Parish in Kewanee for our **Mission Appeal Sunday**. Father John will be at Mass, that weekend, to speak about the mission appeal for the Diocese of Kayanga in Tanzania, raising money to pay for the tuition of seminarians.

Information about the Diocese of Kayanga, Tanzania:

The Holy Father created Kayanga Catholic Diocese in August 2008. It is located in the extreme northwestern corner of Tanzania in East Africa where electricity and running water are, for the most part, unknown. There are no paved roads and a number of them are impassable during the rainy season. The Gospel was brought to this area about 100 years ago and rapidly the Church took root. About 66 percent of the total population is Catholic.

With such phenomenal growth in the faith so does the need for priests to minister to the faithful. The new diocese has been blessed with many young people who want to train for the priesthood. The challenge we have is lack of funds to meet the needs for the training. We are fundraising in order to establish a fund for the training of these young people who will be important agents of evangelization in the near future. Although seminary training is cheap in Tanzania, the new diocese is not able to meet all the needs for the big number of seminarians. It costs the diocese about \$30 to pay for school supplies for a seminarian in the month. Tuition is \$1,500 a year. Please consider giving to this mission.

**St. Anthony's Church Stained Glass**

**Window Report:** We are currently looking into replacing the old, damaged Plexiglas, protective coverings on the outside of Church windows. While the windows themselves are in pretty good shape, for being 100 years old, there are a few that need repairing or restoring.

We have received two of the three bids and they are lower than we had first expected. As a result, we do not anticipate the need to run an entire capital campaign to fund this project. The parish is debt free and we can use income from the Spring Raffle, Trivia Night, Circle Fundraiser proceeds along with bequests from parishioners to fund the project over the next two fiscal years. It is important, however, that we maintain at least our current weekly level of giving to the Parish and come closer to meeting our goal for the Annual Diocesan Appeal since any shortfall must be paid from parish funds to the Diocese. Any overage in the ADA will be returned to the parish and used for the stained glass window project. The Stained-Glass Restoration-Protection Project is the last in our Strategic Plan which began in 2006. Thank You, for your generosity, hard work and commitment to St. Anthony's Parish.
