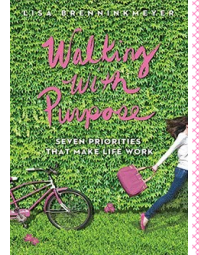

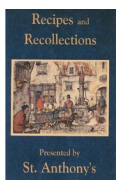
### THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS
