

As stated in a letter from the Bishop's Office dated May 13, 2020, we are continuing with no public Masses for the time being. However, there is the possibility to receive Holy Communion outside of Mass and out-of-doors. Please, know that you are still dispensed from the obligation of attending Mass. It would be advisable for those with existing medical conditions, or sick or of a certain age to remain at home and not come to take communion. For those who are well physically and understanding the risks of these times, may come for confession and or communion to be distributed in the parking lots of Sacred Heart and St. Anthony's.

There will be the opportunity to also go to confession. You will have the option of going anonymously or face - to - face.

Saturdays (Beginning May 16)

SA - Confession ONLY from 3 pm - 3:45 pm

Sundays (Beginning May 17)

SH: 8 am - 8:30 am - Confession and/or Communion

SA: 10 am - 10:30 am - Confession and/or Communion

*Those going to confession - a mask or face covering will be required

**Those coming to receive communion will remain in your car and be directed by attendants. If cars would enter at the Entrance on Church Street and exit at the exit on Main Street at St. Anthony's. At Sacred Heart please use the entrance on Main Street and use the Exit on State Street.

***For Communion there will be a ritual lead by Father or one of the Deacons. To receive communion, I suggest you have your hand/hands open and arms resting at the base of the open window.
