•St. Anthony attendees must enter only through the middle front doors or the handicapped entrance.

•Sacred Heart attendees may enter through all of the three main entrances. We ask that you arrive early because of the new safety protocol.
•Everyone will be met at the door by an usher who will direct them to their seats and remain there until dismissed by an usher after

Mass ends in order to keep the required spacing. This is a firm requirement necessary for us to keep our certification for Public Mass from the Diocese.

•Collection baskets will not be passed during the offertory. Your contributions can be left in the places indicated.

•There will be no gift procession during the offertory; There will be no sign of peace before there Lamb of God.
•Holy Communion will be taken to those in the "mask only" section as before. Others will receive communion by coming up the center aisle at SA and at SH using the side aisles and returning to their seats. Holy communion will continue under only one species. The Precious Blood will not be distributed. (continued on back).

Covid Protocols for St. Anthony's Church in Phase 5, June 11, 2021 (continued from front):

Pew tape and social distancing tape will be removed from Church except for the "mask only" section which is located on the west side from the handicapped entrance to central west door.

Those who wish to be in the "mask only" section will be directed by the usher to that section and they may enter and leave through the handicapped ramp door. Mask wearers who do not want to sit in the "mask only" section may sit elsewhere.

Holy water will now be in use. Hand sanitizer will remain available as before.

The SA choir will resume singing.

Reflections Readings Fifteenth Sunday in ordinary time: Amos 7:12-15, Psalms 85:9-14, Ephesians 1:3-14, Mark 6:7-13

In commissioning the Apostles in today's Gospel, Jesus gives them, and us, a preview of His Church's mission after the Resurrection. His instructions to the Twelve echo those of God to the twelve tribes of Israel on the eve of their exodus from Egypt. The Israelites likewise were sent out with no bread and only one set of clothes, wearing sandals and carrying a staff (see Exodus 12:11; Deuteronomy 8:2–4). Like the Israelites, the Apostles are to rely solely on the providence of God and His grace. Perhaps, also, Mark wants us to see the Apostles' mission, the mission of the Church, as that of leading a new exodus—delivering people from their exile from God and bringing them to the promised land, the kingdom of heaven. Like Amos in today's First Reading, the Apostles are not "professionals" who earn their bread by prophesying. Like Amos, they are simply men (see Acts 14:15) summoned from their ordinary jobs and sent by God to be shepherds of their brothers and sisters. Again this week, we hear the theme of rejection: Amos experiences it, and Jesus warns the Apostles that some will not welcome or listen to them. The Church is called not necessarily to be successful but only to be faithful to God's command. With authority and power given to her by Jesus, the Church proclaims God's peace and salvation to those who believe in Him, as we sing in today's Psalm. This word of truth, this Gospel of salvation, is addressed to each of us, personally, as Paul proclaims in today's Epistle. In the mystery of God's will, we have been chosen from before the foundation of the world—to be His sons and daughters, to live for the praise of His glory. Let us, then, give thanks for the Church today, and for the spiritual blessings He has bestowed upon us. Let us resolve to further the Church's mission—to help others hear the call to repentance and welcome Christ into their lives.
