- 2) Sacramental Confession within 20 days of the act of passing through the doors.
- Receive the Eucharist after confession. 4) Pray for the intentions of the Pope, typically an Our Father, Hail Mary, and the Glory Be.
- Be Free of all attachment to sin. The 5) indulgence is granted when this
