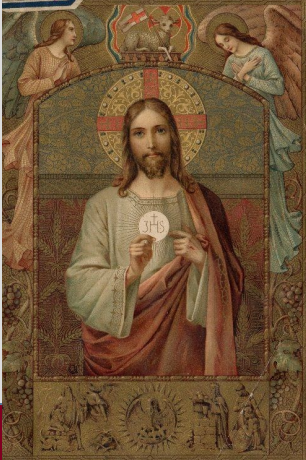

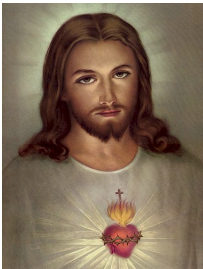
IMPORTANT UPDATE: 2024 ADA

Practical Suggestions for Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

2 Read a portion of one of the Gospels every day
Consider reading the Gospel for the Mass of the day, or a chapter a day. Read prayerfully so as to encounter Jesus, and to experience the love

4 Place an image of the Sacred Heart in your home, and consecrate your family to the Sacred Heart
Devotion to the love of the Sacred Heart can strengthen the love at the heart of each family.

1 Make a Holy Hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament
Spending an hour with Jesus is the only thing relating to himself that he specifically asked of us, when he said in the Garden of Gethsemane: “So, could you not watch with me one hour?” (Matthew 26:40)

3 Attend Mass on first Fridays of the month
It is spiritually valuable to participate in Mass at any time, but to do so on consecutive First Fridays is a custom associated with devotion to the Sacred Heart.

5 Carry an image of the Sacred Heart
Use it as a constant reminder of the generous love of Jesus which it symbolizes. Put that love into practice throughout the day.

The Shroud of Turin has long been venerated by the faithful and is believed by many to be the burial cloth of Jesus of Nazareth. The



Shroud is one of the most scientifically studied religious icons in history. After decades of exhaustive and medical, historical and scientific research, the Center for the Study of the

Passion of the Christ and the Holy Shroud has developed a moving and informative mobile exhibit on the Shroud of Turin. The centerpiece is a full length canvas replica of the Shroud made by the Shroud of Turin Education and Research Association, Inc. In addition, the mobile exhibit contains a large crucified corpus showing the wounds of Christ corresponding to the passion narrative in the Gospel accounts and the wounds shown on the Shroud. The exhibit contains over 31 pop-up display banners detailing the history and science of the Shroud.

Jubilee Year and Indulgences 2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year

What is the Jubilee Year: A special year of reconciliation pilgrimage, and coming home. Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as “Pilgrims of Hope.”

Requirements for obtaining an indulgent.
1) Pass through the holy doors with a spirit of faith and conversion. It represents the pilgrims desire to leave behind sin and embrace Gods Mercy.
2) Sacramental Confession within 20 days of the act of passing through the doors.
3) Receive the Eucharist after confession.
4) Pray for the intentions of the Pope, typically an Our Father, Hail Mary, and the Glory Be.
5) Be Free of all attachment to sin. The indulgence is granted when this condition is met with sincerity and effort. Additionally, the church extends the indulgence to those who are ill, elderly or unable to physically pass through the Holy doors. Jubilee Churches in the Diocese of Peoria
