

Requirements for obtaining an indulgent.

- Pass through the holy doors with a 1) spirit of faith and conversion. It represents the pilgrims desire to leave behind sin and embrace Gods Mercy.
- Sacramental Confession within 20 2) days of the act of passing through the doors.
- Receive the Eucharist after confes-3) sion.
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope, 4) typically an Our Father, Hail Mary, and the Glory Be.
- 5) Be Free of all attachment to sin. The indulgence is granted when this condition is met with sincerity and effort.

Additionally, the church extends the indulgence to those who are ill, elderly or unable to physically pass through the Holy doors.
